

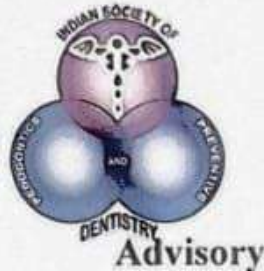

- C** Clean – *Washing and sanitizing hands frequently, Fumigate your clinic often*
C Cover – *Face, nose and eyes – proper barrier technique should be followed*
C Confine – *Yourself at home*
- O** Observe – *Individuals carefully & ask for any symptoms of cough, fever, cold & congestion*
O Online or telephonic consultation, if possible
- R** Restrict – *To emergency treatment only & all elective treatment to be postponed as far as possible*

- N** No use of aerosol generating instruments like Airtor, Ultrasonic scalers etc.
Use only hand instruments and slow speed hand piece in emergency situation

SUMMARY COVID - 19 Measures for Dental Offices.

-  Hand Hygiene has been Considered the Most Critical Measure.
-  Thorough Disinfection of all Surfaces.
-  Face Shields and Goggles are Essential with use of High or Low-Speed Drilling with Water Spray.
-  Preoperative Antimicrobial Mouth Rinse Could Reduce the Number of Microbes in the Oral Cavity.
-  Use Gowns or Long Sleeve Shirts.
-  Minimize Operations that can Produce Droplets or Aerosols. The Use of Saliva Ejectors with low or High Volume can Reduce the Production of Droplets and Aerosols.
-  Establish Pre-Check Triages to Measure and Record the Temperature of Every Staff and Patient as a Routine Procedure.
-  In Areas where COVID- 19 Spreads, Nonemergency Dental Practices Should be Postponed.
