We all went back to the conference, leaving sir with his faculty. Almost everyone in the conference venue was expressing remorse over the incident.

The day went by and things moved the way they always do. However, the last day of PedoTal will be remembered forever as the ISPPD members sitting in the Narmada Hall witnessed this Braveheart walk confidently onto the stage and with a smile. He had been discharged from hospital in morning and had to take strong painkillers to manage the excruciating post-operative pain. But he rose to the occasion and came to fulfil his duty as our general secretary. He did it at his best and all the members gave an ovation to his dedication to ISPPD and the profession.

The reason I wished to write this editorial was to let this incident be recorded forever in ISPPD Archives, so that the pediatric dentists in India can look up to mentors like Dr. Nikhil Srivastava and feel motivated to do good.

CONFERENCE REPORT

The department of pediatric and preventive dentistry, People's college of dental science and research center successfully organized the 43rd National ISPPD Conference PEDOTAAL at Bhopal from 23rd November, 2022 to 26th November 2022. The preconference courses were inaugurated on 23rd November 2022; with a registration of 185 delegates guided by 21 faculties in 12 varied workshops. This day was concluded with executive committee meeting of ISPPD. On 24th evening, grand inauguration to the conference was conducted. The scientific extravaganza held from 24th to 26th November included 6 international keynote speaker sessions, 23 national keynote speaker sessions and 34 guest speaker sessions. The scientific events comprised of 7 colloquiums, brainstorming and icebreaking session and multitude of guest lectures by eminent speakers. The fun element, caricature competition was included in the scientific extravaganza which was enjoyed by the students. We had an amazing array of presentations which were 112 faculty paper presentations, 650 students paper presentation, 192 student posters, 4 mime videos and 14 short film videos. Out of which 142 participants received best presentation awards. On 25th night, there was a splendid gala banquet with the theme black and gold. The scientific extravaganza was concluded by a valedictory function which was followed by annual general body meeting of the ISPPD.



Report on “Open Secrets” Reviewers and Authors Training workshop organized by ISPPD at KSR Dental College, Tiruchengode, Tamilnadu

A two-day training program “The Open Secret – Authors and Reviewers Workshop” was organized by the Indian Society of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry (ISPPD) and hosted by the Editor-in-Chief of JISPPD, Dr. Sharath Asokan and the Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry, KSR Institute of Dental Science and Research, Tiruchengode on 15th and 16th October 2022. 
Hazaribag College of Dental Sciences and Hospital, Hazaribagh (H.C.D.S.H.), Jharkhand


Member's Achievements
