he Indian Society of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry (ISPPD) is a national society specifically concerned with the oral health of children in India. It aims to improve oral health in children and encourage the highest standards of clinical care. ISPPD has over 2000 Pediatric Dentists as life members.

"The emblem of the society is based on the famous triad of Keyes (1960). One circle represents the tooth, the other the bacteria and the third diet. The shaded area of intersection of the circles represents dental caries. The Stress given is that for caries to develop all the three factors are essential; caries cannot occur if one factor is missing. Incidentally, this area of inter section of circles takes the form of Triangles. The triangle connotes two aspects- it represents delta, which is the sign of dentistry & it depicts the pedodontic triangle as given by Wright (1975). The three corners of triangles are indicative of (a) Child, (b) Mother (parent) and (c) Dentist. This triangle represents 1:2 transaction for the management of children. The top circle of keys in the emblem carries symbols of the emblem of the Indian dental Association (IDA)- Staff of Aesculpius with wings of serpents encircling around it. The staff of Aesculpius stands of captor of authority and represents the professional authority of association. The serpents show the power of healing since serpents ages back have been used for healing. Hippocrates adopted this symbol and we have adopted it with two serpents entwined around the staff in opposite directions. The wings on the staff represents the spread of knowledge. The wings have 6 small and 3 large divisions as in the IDA emblem."

The Indian Society of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry has been formed on the firm belief that "Every child has a fundamental right to his total oral health". The Society has an obligation to fulfill this faith.

Indian Society of Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry

SPPD organized the following events in 2021: 42nd "PEDODISHA-21; Annual Conference Curriculum Meet the Culture" was organized in November. The main highlights of the four-day conference included 6 foreign speakers, including Dr Marcelo Bönecker and Dr Jeffrey Dean, 12 preconference courses. along with 946 oral and 428 poster presentations. 1,965 delegates attended. Dr Susant Mohanty was the Organizing Chairman.

A reviewer's training program on "Effective Peer Review" under the chairmanship of Dr Radhika Muppa was organized in October. The aim of the workshop was to improve the peer review process for the society's PubMed indexed Journal (JISPPD). ISPPD "Faculty Development Programme; Training the Teachers" was organized on virtual mode under the chairmanship of Dr Shabnam Zahir. More than 250 faculty members working in different dental colleges attended. Three public awareness competitions - Oral Health Day, Children's Day and Teacher's Day - were organized with the aim to increase dental health awareness amongst children, their parents and primary school teachers. 101 dental colleges and approximately 40,000 primary school children participated.

"PedoVirCon-2021; Enhancing Skills through Demonstration" was organized in January, inaugurated by Dr Marcelo Bonceker, IAPD President. Speakers enlightened the delegates through video demonstrations on 25 different topics. Dr Shantanu Choudhari was the chief coordinator. A "Virtual Pedo RaRe-2; A Rapid Revision Summit" was held in April 2021 for postgraduate students to rapidly revise the syllabus before the university examination. The summit included 24 lectures. The chief coordinator of this program was Dr Sharath Asokan. A national-level Essay Competition was also organized for Indian pediatric dentists on the following topics - "Caries Excavation; Current Concepts and Techniques" and "3D Printing; Its Applications in Pediatric Dentistry". 103 entries were received; and Dr Shraddha Saika from ITS Dental College won 1st prize.












International Yoga Day

This app has an in-built calculator for calculating dosages of drugs for children. It also makes a prescription ready to share in various ways. PREASY makes prescriptions three times faster, and with more accuracy than the handwritten prescriptions! PREASY is thus an 'easy' choice for a 'busy' dentist!

PREASY works in four quick steps:

Step 1: Register as the Dentist.

Step 2: Enter the patient details.

Step 3: Select medicines (PREASY will calculate dosages as per the weight of the child).

Step 4: Generate and share the prescription.





About Team PREASY:

The app was conceptualized by **Dr. Ashwin Jawdekar**, who is a Professor and Head, Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed-to-be University Dental College and Hospital, Navi Mumbai (India) and Director of Little Smiles Childcare Pvt. Ltd. The app was developed by **Dr. Kedar Bakshi** (Dental Surgeon and Consultant Implantologist) and **Malhar Bakshi** (an Engineering student). Research on the app was conducted by **Dr. Shamika Kamath** (Assistant Professor, Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed-to-be University Dental College and Hospital, Navi Mumbai), **Dr Ashwin Jawdekar** and **Dr. Amar Katre** (Professor and Head, Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry GD Pol Foundation's YMT Dental College and Hospital, Navi Mumbai.

The app-launch is another step in the series of success stories so far:

- 1. PREASY APP development received partial funding for research from Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University, Pune.
- 2. Research based on PREASY APP was published in a peer reviewed international journal: Kamath et al: Comparison of Dentist Preference towards Software Based Versus Handwritten Prescriptions in Pediatric Dental Patients- A Mixed Methods Study. JPRI, 33(41A): 41-49, 2021.
- 3. A paper by Dr Shamika Kamath at the Conference of South Asian Association of Pediatric Dentistry in Pune (December 2021) won a joint third prize in Faculty presentations.






