

- The Award will be be presented at the **ISPPD Annual Conference** every year to the winner who is a **POST GRADUATE STUDENT**(Life members are not eligible for the award)

(A Post Graduate is one, who is pursuing his/her specialization in the subject of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry in an institute established and recognized under the laws any where across INDIA).

- A post-graduate student is eligible to apply for the award **ONLY ONCE** during his/her post-graduation period.
- The applicant must be a member of The Indian Society of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry (ISPPD)

- Articles must have been published before the last date of submission.
- If there is a tie between two or more submissions, the publication with the highest impact factor will be chosen. Impact factor to be decided, based on Clarivate analytics followed by Scimago
- If the impact factor is not, or cannot be stated, **indexing** will be considered in the order of Clarivate analytics (WOS), PubMed, Scopus, followed by others.
- While evaluating publications for an award, the preference will be given in the following order
 - (i) A systematic review
 - (ii) Original research
 - (iii) Letter to the editor
 - (iv) Narrative review
 - (v) **Case report,** and last
 - (vi) Guest Editorial.
 - If more than one postgraduate student contributed to a single publication as authors, the award shall go to the postgraduate student with higher order of authorship.
 - If **no entries** are received with post-graduate students listed as the first author, the second or third, or fourth author should be taken into consideration, and **rest all the above criteria would remain the same**.


Departmental Achievements

Dr. HSRSM Dental College & Hospital, Hingoli, Maharashtra

Dental fear and anxiety among children are prevalent from early childhood through adolescence. Managing an anxious child becomes of utmost priority in delivering a quality dental treatment. Nitrous Oxide sedation is an effective option to alleviate pain and reduce anxiety & fear of patients undergoing dental treatment. Learning the same during post graduation training is a boon and we are happy to share that we have installed the sedation unit by Baldus in our department at Dr. HSRSM Dental College & Hospital, Hingoli, Maharashtra.

A proud moment for me and my 2nd year post graduate student, Dr. Rajvi Shah as we received our copyright for the "Hop-a-Dent" game from The Copyright Office, Govt. of India. The cornerstone of a child's education and behavior management is the "Tell-show-do" method. This technique is led by the operator. The tell-show-do technique was modified into the tell-play-do (TPD) technique. In this, children are asked to play with toys that imitate dental instruments which provides more explanatory concept and helps them to know the dental procedure in a simpler way. The entire technique is led by the child. This innovative twist to the conventional game will definitely help in managing children's behavior better.

Dr. Ankita Chandak received the third prize in the practitioner's category for her presentation titled "Management of nonvital young permanent teeth: Let's Apexify it!" at IDA Nagpur on 18th February 2024.



Sibar Institute of Dental Sciences, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh

On the eve of World Thalassemia Day (8th May 2024) Department of Paediatric and Preventive Dentistry, Sibar Institute of Dental Sciences, Guntur organized an awareness program to provide education regarding critical dental care for young patients suffering from inherited blood illness. In the day-long event, 60 children and their family members actively participated in educational sessions about oral hygiene, nutrition, and the importance of dental care in these children. Oral screening was performed to identify oral health needs and personalised dental care program has been designed. Individuals with dental emergencies were prioritized and planned to treat the cases under physician supervision. Refreshments(Fruits) and oral hygiene kits (Toothpaste, Tooth-brush, Mouthwash) were distributed to the participants.



On the eve of World No Tobacco Day (31st May 2024) the department organized a public awareness program to sensitize the parents and children about the ill effects of using tobacco, both smoke less and smoke-form related products. This was done in collaboration with IDA and ISPPD. Post graduate students arranged a photo exhibition for general public emphasizing the importance of Protecting children from tobacco industry interference. Our faculty member, Dr. Chaitanya Mohan gave a power point presentation about the endangering effect of tobacco usage on younger generation

This was executed by Dr Charan Teja V (Associate Professor & Incharge Head), Dr Saravana Kumar K (Assistant Professor) and Dr Ragini K (Assistant Professor). Dr Padmanabhan Yuvaraj, Director, The Dental Academy, Coimbatore was the resource person for the workshop. A total of 30 clinicians and academicians in around the districts attended the programme. A live demonstration of performing pulpectomy and impaction on pediatric and adult patients respectively under conscious sedation was done.

Department of Dentistry Government Medical College and Hospital Sector 32 Chandigarh

The Department of Dentistry Government Medical College and hospital sector 32 Chandigarh in collaboration with IDA Chandigarh state branch and ICD section VI observed the World No Tobacco Day(31stMay)on 30th May in the Department of Dentistry. The staff of hospital including safai karamcharis,attendants and patients visiting the hospital were made aware about the ill effects of Tobacco use.Awareness talk on harmful effects of Tobacco was given with powerpoint presentation. The talk started with emphasis on the Theme of this year "Protecting children from Tobacco industry interface". They were educated about creating awareness of ill effects of Tobacco in their children and neighbourhood so that we can give rise to a healthy and Tobacco free society. Also effects of Tobacco cessation were also discussed. Some of the patients who had been smokers and had developed oral cancer and had been successfully treated at the hospital also motivated the participants to quit smoking so that they do not develop oral cancer and other complications of Tobacco use.







Government Dental College and Hospital, Nagpur, Maharashtra

The Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry at the Government Dental College and Hospital in Nagpur won 3rd prize for their outstanding activities during the ISPPD Oral Health Day Celebration 2024.

Dr. Ritesh Kalaskar, the esteemed Professor and Head of the Department was recently recognized with several prestigious awards for his outstanding contributions to pediatric dentistry. He received the National Level Pierre Fauchard Academy Award for Best Pedodontist at the 37th PFA Annual Conference in Bangalore 2024, and the Fellow ISPPD Award for 2023 at the 44th National Conference of the Indian Society of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry in Ahmedabad. Dr Kalaskar received 2nd Best Innovation Award at the DMER-GDCH Dental Education and Research Summit 2024, Nagpur for the "Obturagun," a novel device designed for root canal obturation in primary teeth.

Dr Kalaskar along with Dr Shivani Bhadule also received the best innovation award in the prestigious Genesis Gen Z National Level Project Competition, hosted by National institute of Technology College, Nagpur for their innovation titled Pedoplant Implant. This innovative implant design aims to address the challenge of replacing missing teeth in children, offering a specialized solution that considers the unique requirements of young patients.

Dr Ritesh Kalaskar also won the medicos badminton league organized by medicos badminton association Nagpur on 3rd march 2024. In mixed category he won the title and in double category he was runner up. Dr. Nupur Ninawe, Associate Professor in department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry at the Government Dental College and Hospital, Nagpur was recognized with the ISPPD Distinguished Women's Award on 8th March 2024.





KD Dental College and Hospital, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh

A Dental health check-up camp was organised by Department of Pediatric and Preventive dentistry, Kanti Devi dental College and hospital Mathura, under the guidance of Dr. Sonal Gupta (Prof. and HOD), Dr. Sushma (Professor), Dr. Rajeev Singh (Reader) and Dr. Jyoti Sharma (Reader). It involved five schools of the Mathura region namely Rajiv International school, Ramanlal Shorawala public school, Ramanlal Shorawala (senior wing)-12/4/24, and Ramanlal Shorawala primary School, Dampier nagar. A total of 1,104 students were screened and educated regarding importance and maintenance of oral health. They were trained with proper tooth brushing techniques too. An oral hygiene kit sponsored by Colgate comprising of toothbrush and toothpaste was disturbed among 300 children.

A total of 150 Special children who were Blind were examined by TELL, TOUCH and DO method. A general oral health screening was done through BRAILE method oral hygiene instructions were demonstrated to the Blind children. These children were totally blind and partially blind. We collect their data through their handicapped lds issues by government.

Several awareness camps were also conducted such as dental screening camps at Kendriya Vidhyalaya, AFS, Avadi, Chennai on 8th and 10th April 2024, and Vijayantha Senior Secondary School in Avadi on 12th April 2024. A session on oral awareness and dietary counselling for parents was held on April 15, 2024. An oral health screening camp also took place at All the children Orphanage in Karapakkam, Chennai.

Additionally, Dr. Navami Gopan, Dr. Sreni K. S., Dr. Amilia Elizabeth, Dr. Neena, and Dr. Priya Mahesh completed the NEP 2020 Orientation under the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme. Dr. Parisa Norouzi Baghkomeh also attended a program on Dental anesthesia at the conclave held on June 15-16, 2024. Dr. J. Mohammed Farzan, Prof and Head delivered a guest lecture at the 6th SPARC CDE program organized by Saveetha Dental College and Hospital on June 28 and 29, and Dr. Parisa Norouzi Baghkomeh was awarded a certificate of achievement under the category 'Best dental Practitioner – Pedodontist' by IDA – Greater Chennai Branch on 16th June 2024.




Oral Health Sciences Centre, PGIMER, Chandigarh

The National Resource Centre for Oral Healthcare of Children & Elderly, under the National Oral Health Program at the Oral Health Sciences Centre, PGIMER Chandigarh, has been actively engaged in a series of impactful activities regarding Oral health care of children in all the 112 Government schools in and around Chandigarh. Notable amongst these in the present year are preventive measures and comprehensive oral health promotion initiatives including piloting a tooth-brushing program in two schools, applying antibacterial agents and fluoride varnish among young children in ten schools, conducting extensive oral health screenings, and providing thorough oral health education. Additionally, children requiring secondary prevention were referred for curative and rehabilitative management to OHSC, PGIMER. Besides this, a two-day training program for school-teachers was conducted which saw participation from approximately 250 teachers from 142 government schools of Panchkula, Haryana. A capacity-building teachers' training program was conducted, followed by a school-based tooth brushing initiative. Additionally, oral health awareness competitions, including quizzes, poster making and sloganeering, and drawing contests were organized for children and teachers from these schools this year. I am happy to share that a novel method of Oral health promotion amongst school children through creation of a 'school oral health wall' is underway in a phased manner among 112 government schools of Chandigarh, which is the first of its kind. Several key initiatives have also been launched to promote oral health among children with special healthcare needs in Chandigarh UT. These initiatives include tailored oral health education and promotion activities. The designing and development of age-specific, target-audience-oriented IEC materials, including seven posters (tactile graphic) and two radio jingles in Hindi, have already been released. Imparting oral health education to these children in the form of entertainment and games (Edutainment) for better assimilation is underway, along with demonstrations of proper brushing techniques to them.



To augment our oral health promotion activities, an oral health promotion video in Indian Sign Language was produced and launched on World Oral Health Day, 20.3.2024, specifically for deaf and hard-of-hearing children and adolescents. Inclusive posters featuring tactile (Braille-scripted) graphics for visually impaired children were also developed and launched on the same day by our honourable Chief Guest Prof. Naresh K. Panda, Dean(Academics), PGI. A first of its kind initiative, "Anant Muskaan," funded by ICMR has been launched as a multi-site implementation research project focusing on primary school-based tooth brushing and oral health education among 6-10 years old school children. This project includes a total of 447 government and private schools and approximately 77000 school going children across Panchkula district of Haryana, featuring flexible scheduling for tooth brushing sessions, and active participation from community volunteers and parents. The primary objectives of this project are :assessment of current tooth brushing practices, identifying barriers and facilitators for implementing oral health interventions, and evaluating the effectiveness of an optimized school tooth brushing model in improving oral hygiene behaviors and its impact on dental caries.
